Brief Facts

During practice landings at the airport the right main landing gear axle sheared causing the aircraft to drift off the runway resulting in a ground loop with the aircraft coming to rest upside down.

General Description of Damage

The aircraft came to rest upside down. The impact caused damage to the propeller and sudden stoppage to the piston engine. The fuselage frame distorted along the entire length of the aircraft. Both wings were impacted; wing spars, struts, leading edges, and the entire structure of both wings were twisted. The vertical stabilizer was crumpled. The wing root and windshield area crumpled causing the windshield to shatter. The right main landing gear axle failed, causing damage to the rim and spar as well as the brake assembly.
