Brief Facts

While landing the pilot lost directional control in a gust of wind, the aircraft hit the ground and sustained impact damage.

General Description of Damage

The aircraft sustained substantial impact-related damage affecting the engine, propeller, forward fuselage, firewall, landing gear, wings, and empennage. The observed damage is consistent with a hard landing followed by landing gear collapse, resulting in a forward impact and subsequent load transfer throughout the airframe.
