


2020 COVID-19 Claims Data

COVID-19 is a generational event that has significantly impacted our daily lives. From a stop loss perspective, COVID-19 is both a new diagnosis and potential claim expense that was not previously expected. Tokio Marine HCC – Stop Loss Group (TMHCC) is sharing their data on COVID-19 to keep their customers and partners better informed on its impact. The claims data provided below is based on claims paid by the employer's medical plan for which TMHCC has received either a notice or a claim reimbursement request.
