Considerations

1. Conduct a Comprehensive Risk Assessment

- Identify site-specific vulnerabilities and threats.
- Evaluate physical, operational, and behavioral risks.

2. Develop an Active Assailant Response Plan

- Include lockdown, evacuation, and shelter-in-place protocols.
- Assign clear roles to employees and security teams.

3. Establish a Behavioral Threat Assessment Team (BTAT)

- Form a team (HR, security, legal, mental health, etc.) to monitor risks.
- Create confidential reporting mechanisms.

4. Implement Access Control & Surveillance

- Use keycard/biometric access systems.
- Install CCTV and audit footage regularly.

5. Train Staff in Situational Awareness

- Conduct regular "Run, Hide, Fight" drills.
- Train employees to identify and report warning signs.

6. Partner with Local Law Enforcement

- Share building layouts and emergency plans.
- Invite officers to participate in drills and planning.

7. Enable Mass Notification Systems

- Deploy alerts via SMS, apps, and intercom.
- Use pre-written messages for different scenarios.

8. Secure Critical Infrastructure

- · Harden high-value areas (server rooms, control rooms).
- Install reinforced doors and protective glass where needed.

9. Review & Update Plans Regularly

- Conduct annual plan reviews and after-action evaluations.
- Keep emergency contacts and floor plans up to date.

10. Provide Post-Incident Support

- Offer counseling and mental health services.
- Include recovery, communication, and continuity plans.


